

2 Chronicles 20:1-13

What do you do when you are afraid?

We have much to concern us each day

Lets look at the example set by king
Jehoshaphat

Jehoshaphat was afraid

Three kingdoms were marching toward
Judah

Moabites, Ammonites and Meunites

They had already conquered Hazazon
Tamar known as Engedi

They were larger and stronger than Israel

Jehoshaphat set himself to seek the LORD

At that moment he made a choice to live
by faith and not by sight

He proclaimed a fast throughout the land

They gathered together to seek God

Jehoshaphat Prayed

You are God in heaven

You drove out the inhabitants of the land

You gave it to Israel forever

O our God, wilt thou not judge them? for we have no might against this great company that cometh against us; neither know we what to do: but our eyes are upon thee Verse 12

Jahaziel Prophesizes

Came the Spirit of the Lord on him

Be not afraid of the great multitude

The battle is not yours but God's - 15B

Tomorrow go down against them

You will not need to fight in battle

Stand still and see the salvation of the
Lord Vs17

They all fell before the Lord and worshiped him

Jehoshaphat stood and said, Hear me, O Judah, and ye inhabitants of Jerusalem; Believe in the LORD your God, so shall ye be established; believe his prophets, so shall ye prosper. *2 Chronicles 20:20*

Faith is the Victory

And when they began to sing and to praise, the LORD set ambushments against the children of Ammon, Moab, and mount Seir, which were come against Judah; and they were smitten.
