

1 John 5:10-13

He that believeth on the Son of God hath the witness in himself: he that believeth not God hath made him a liar; because he believeth not the record that God gave of his Son. ¹¹ And this is the record, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. ¹² He that hath the Son hath life; *and* he that hath not the Son of God hath not life.

¹³ These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God

You can know that you have eternal life

*These things have I written unto you that
believe on the name of the Son of God; that
ye may know that ye have eternal life*

Of all the things we need to be sure of,
eternal life should be first.

You either have eternal life or you don't

You can be sure today that you will live
forever.

Who can guarantee us that we will go to heaven?

Hoping That God would find you “good
enough” is not it.

Only God can make this promise

Sources other than God’s word are only
man’s opinion and not God’s promise

God is faithful to what he has said

There are many who have made God to be a liar -Verse 10

Anyone who disagrees with what Jesus
has said

Those who attempt to add to, change, or
exclude certain parts of his word

People who prefer their own ideas over
what God has said

*Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth,
and the life: no man cometh unto the Father,
but by me. John 14:6*

There is only one way that God will give us eternal life

*He that hath the Son hath life; and he that hath
not the Son of God hath not life - Verse 12*

God has given us a way to be restored to
him

If we accept his way we receive his gift of
eternal life

If we choose anything else we do not have
eternal life

How to have eternal life

Admit that you are apart from God

This is repenting and confessing our sin

Believe that Jesus, God's only Son, died
for our sin

Accept Jesus as who he is, Our Savior
and Lord

The witness in yourself - Verse 10

Who hath also sealed us, and given the earnest of the Spirit in our hearts. 2 Corinthians 1:22

The presence of the Spirit of God is our proof

The confirmation of our belief is in this witness of his Spirit
