

John 7:37-39

In the last day, that great *day* of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink. He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water. (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet *given*; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)

What flows from you?

What is most often the content of your presence.

Does the same come from your heart both public and private

For some there is no flow at all

The fruit of the Spirit

Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain: John 15:16

We should bear: Love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faith, gentleness, self-control.

Does the well of our soul bring forth such things?

Are we spiritually dehydrated?

We can be filled with many good things
but be spiritually dry

We will flow forth with much, but not that
which God desires

Our lives are full but not abundant with
the Lord's supply

If anyone is thirsty

There is only one that quenches our thirst

The indwelling Spirit is the only source of
fulfillment

Our lives are in need of this one true thing

The source of our flow

Come to me - Jesus

Spiritual gifts come from the Spirit Giver

We must choose the source of our depths

And Drink!

Desiring the Lord to quench our thirst

A consistent taking in of Him

Streams of living water

From the drink in, to the stream flowing
